**Order Restoring Protected Person to
Capacity**

This matter came on for hearing before the district court on _____ on a petition seeking restoration to capacity of the Protected Person, named above. The matter, having been considered by the Court, and the Court being duly advised in the premises now makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Findings of Capacity:
Conservatorship: The Protected Person has presented a prima facie case that the Protected Person is able to manage property and business affairs. The Protected Person does not have property which will be dissipated without proper management, or funds are not needed for the support, care, education, health, and welfare of the Protected Person or of individuals who are entitled to the individual's support. Such case is evidenced by the following facts: _____

2. No other person has presented sufficient facts to rebut the prima facie case.
3. The court has followed the same procedures to safeguard the rights of the Protected Person as applied for a petition for Conservatorship.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- 1) That _____ is hereby restored to capacity and all of said person's rights and powers are hereby restored effective immediately.
- 2) The Conservatorship of _____ is hereby terminated.
- 3) That the court appointed attorney for the Protected Person, if any, is hereby discharged.
